What have I been doing? Hin inenüna?

I've been standing here for a little while. Nü'ü iva'an wününün.

I've been sitting here for a little while. Nü'ü karünün iva'an.

What have you been doing? Hin inenaam?

You have been standing here for a while. Im wününaam iva'an.

You have been sitting here for a while. Im karünaam iva'an.

What has he been doing? Hin inenaan?

He's been standing here for a little while. Shi'in wününaan iva'an.

He's been sitting here for a little while. Shi'in karünaan iva'an.

What has he been doing over there? Hin ineneen aween?

He's been standing over there for a little while. Su'un wününeen aween.

He's been sitting over there for a while. Su'un karüneen aween.

What has it been doing? Hin inenaak?

It's been standing here for a little while. Shi'id wününaak iva'an.

What has it been doing over there? Hin ineneek aween?

It's been standing over there. Su'ur wününeek aween.

Who has been buying these clothes? Han nooginaak hiibüz(e)?

We two have been buying clothes. Tam nooginüm hiibüz(a).

Who has been buying those clothes? Han noogineek hiibüz(e) aween?

We have all been buying clothes (not including the listener) Nümü nooginüm hiibüz(e).

Who is buying this food now? Han noogüdeek(a) ka'apita uuv?

Who has been buying this food? Han noogidiik(a) ka'apita?

I have been buying food all morning. Nü'ü nooginün utsakus ka'apita.

These people right here have been buying food all morning. Shi'im iva'an nooginaam ka'apita utsakus(a).

Those people over there have been buying food all day. Su'um aween(a) nooginaam ka'apita suiteava.

Who bought that food? Han noogidaak ka'apita?

I've been washing the dishes for a while. Nü'ü mahanün kwichiz(e).

You've been washing the dishes for a while. Im mahanaam kwichiz(e).

This one has been washing clothes for a while. Shi'in mahanaan hiibüz(e).

That one over there has been washing clothes for a while. Su'un mahaneen hiibüz aween.

We two have been washing clothes for a while. Tam mahanüm hiibüz(e).

They have been preparing food here. Shi'im manhaginaam ka'apita iva'an.

They over there have been preparing food for a while. Su'um aween manhaginaam ka'apita.

We have all been doing something all day. Tawa inenüm hini'iv uitüa.
